Frigid

MATERIALS

Red Heart® All in One™ Granny Square™ (8.8 oz /250 g; 417 yds/381 m)
Cyber Leaf (2021) or Frigid (2004) **1 ball or 91 yds/84 m**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates® yarn needle. Peel & Stick Fabric Fuse. It is **highly** recommended to **not** use iron-on fusing for this project.



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Dc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

SIZE

To fit average adult baseball cap.

GAUGE

12 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To achieve the look shown in photos, work Triangle Motifs and Brim using **only the first 4 colors** as 'self-striping' yarn, allowing colors to change as they appear.

- Make sure to cut off and set aside the longest color length (either Black or Soft White) to use for joining and edges.

Triangle Motif (Make 3)

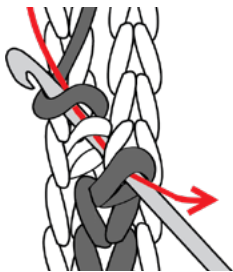
Ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch-2 sp). (3 dc. Ch 2) twice in ring. 2 dc in ring. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

2nd rnd: Sl st in next ch-2 sp. Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch-2 sp). 2 dc in ring. *1 dc in each of next 3 dc to next ch-2 sp. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * once more. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in first ch-2 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

3rd to 5th rnds: Sl st in next ch-2 sp. Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc. Ch-2 sp). 2 dc in ring. *1 dc in each dc to next ch-2 sp. (2 dc. Ch 2. 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp. Rep from * once more. 1 dc in each dc to first ch-2 sp. 1 dc in first ch-2 sp. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-5. Fasten off at end of 5th rnd.

Join Motifs



FLAT SLIP STITCH JOIN

Notes:

- Hold working yarn (Black or Soft White) underneath work to create a flat seam.
- Keep a loose, even tension on the yarn while joining to keep Motifs flat and even. Too tight tension will cause them to bunch up.

Place 2 Motifs beside each other, RS up.

Join yarn (Black or Soft White) with sl st to left Motif in ch-1 corner sp. Insert hook from front to back into back loop of corner ch-1 on this same left Motif. Insert hook from front to back into back loop of corner ch-1 sp of right Motif. (3 loops now on hook). Yoh and draw through 3 loops on hook. *Insert hook from front to back into back loop of next st on left Motif. Insert hook from front to back into back loop of corresponding st of right Motif. Yoh and draw through 3 loops on hook. Rep from * to end of Motif.

Join 3 Motifs along side edges to create Cap top.

BOTTOM EDGE

1st rnd: (RS). Join yarn (Black or Soft White) with sl st to any ch-2 sp along bottom edge. Ch 3 (counts as dc). Work 1 dc into each dc, ch-2 sp and into center of join between each Motif. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. **Do not** fasten off.

Place joined Motifs of Cap onto Hat to determine if another rnd of sts is needed to align with bottom edge of Hat *when slightly stretched*. If needed, work 1 more rnd of either sc, hdc or dc into each dc around to achieve proper depth. Fasten off. Weave in ends on WS.

BRIM

See Diagram on page 3.

Note: Instructions are written to fit an average Baseball cap brim length of approx 3" [7.5 cm] long and 8" [20.5 cm] wide.

Ch 16.

1st row: (RS). 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 3 dc). *1 dc in each of next 2 ch. 2 dc in next ch. Rep from * to last 3 ch. 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Turn. 20 dc.

2nd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in first dc (counts as 3 dc). 1 dc in each of next 5 dc. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 5 dc. 3 dc in last dc. Turn. 26 dc.

3rd row: Ch 3. 2 dc in first dc (counts as 3 dc). 1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next dc. (1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in each of next 8 dc. (2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc) twice. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in next dc. 3 dc in last dc. Turn. 36 dc.

4th row: Sl st in each of first 9 dc. Dc2tog over next 2 dc. (2 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in each of next 10 dc. (2 dc in next dc) twice. Dc2tog. Sl st in next dc. Turn. 20 sts.

5th row: Sl st in first dc2tog and each of next 2 dc. Hdc2tog. 2 hdc in next dc. 1 hdc in each of next 9 dc. 2 hdc in next dc. Hdc2tog. Sl st in next st. 15 sts. Fasten off.

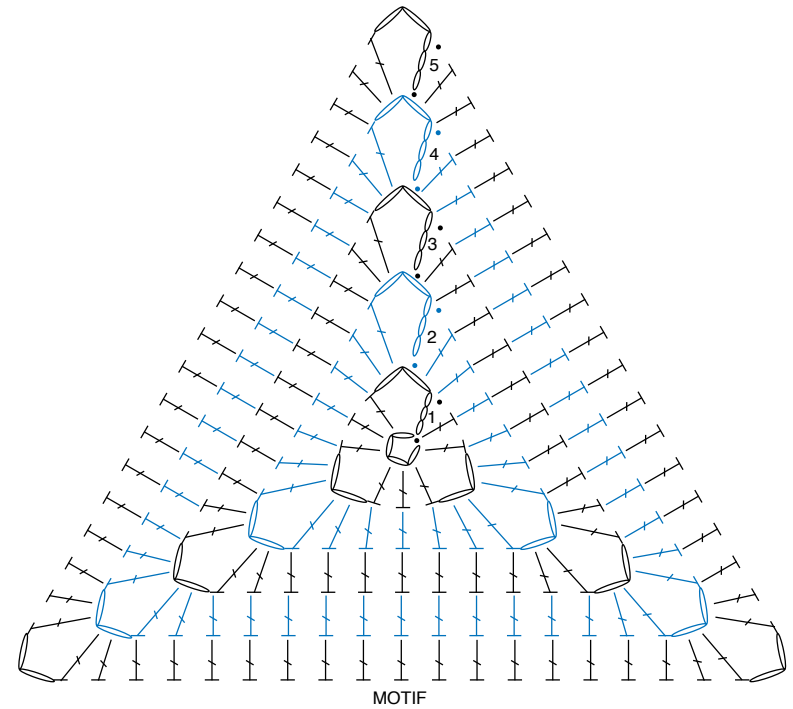
Edging: 1st row: (RS). Join yarn (Black or Soft White) with sc to first dc of 3rd row at right 'corner' of Brim. Work 1 sc in each st to last dc of 3rd row (left 'corner' of Brim). Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Brim to Cap.

FINISHING CAP

Place lengths of Peel and Stick adhesive from top of crown down sides of purchased Cap. Take off **only** the back layer of the tape using Cap seams as guides and pressing firmly into place.

Once tape is positioned, place joined crocheted piece onto Cap, centering 1 Motif at front. Working from top down, carefully peel top layer of tape off and press crocheted piece into place, stretching slightly. Once crocheted piece is properly in position and adhered, it's a good idea to further secure it by placing lengths of Peel and Stick along bottom edge.

After Brim is attached, sew edge of Brim to cap piece with whipstitch using length of yarn (Black or Soft White).



STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- † = single crochet (sc)
- ┌ = half double crochet (hdc)
- └ = double crochet (dc)
- ┘ = half double crochet 2 together (hdc2tog)
- ┙ = double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)

BRIM

Before attaching Brim, it's helpful to place a st marker at center of Brim piece and also mark center of purchased Cap brim. Place lengths of Peel and Stick around Cap brim as close to edge as possible. Peel off top layer of tape and attach crocheted Brim piece, ensuring center markers are aligned.
