And let's start crocheting!:)





STEM

Start to crochet with **GREEN** color yarn.


R1: 6 SC in MR

R2 - R50: 6 SC (50 rounds)

You can fill the stem with fiberfill every 5 rows or insert the wire inside at the end of crocheting.

Cut the yarn leaving a yarn tail.

Close the small hole than remains (take the front loops only). Fasten off. Hide yarn tail inside the detail.



FLOWERS

R1: 6 SC in MR

R2 - R3: 6 SC

R4: CH 5, in 2nd ch from hook crochet:

SC, SC, DC, DC


Then **SL ST** to the next loop of **ROUND 3**.

Again make a **CH 5** and repeat the **sequence** of **ROUND 4**.

Repeat this 4 more times. You should get 6 petals.


Cut yarn, but leave a long tail to assembly. For one stem, you need to crochet 10 flowers.

At this link you can watch a video (sorry, only Russian text) of how I crocheted a flower.



ASSEMBLY

Sew 10 flowers to the stem as shown in the photos. One Hyacinth flower is ready! In order to get a beautiful bouquet, you need to crochet at least 7 such hyacinths.
