# Santa booties

For baby 0-3 months

CROCHET

**Skill level:** Intermediate

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## MATERIALS AND TOOLS:

**Original yarn:** DROPS Safran (100% cotton, 160m/175 yds per 50g/1.8 oz skein) White color - approx. 50 yards, red color - approx. 40 yards. Some black and yellow yarn.

**Yarn weight:** #2 Fine / Sport



**Yarn fiber:** 100% cotton

**Hook:** 1.75 mm.

**Notions:** measuring tape, scissors, stitch markers, tapestry needle

**Gauge:** 24 sc\* 25 rnds = 4" 10cm).

If the sole turns out larger than needed, then crochet tighter or use a hook 0.25-0.5 mm smaller.

## **ABBREVIATIONS:** all stitches are listed in US terms!

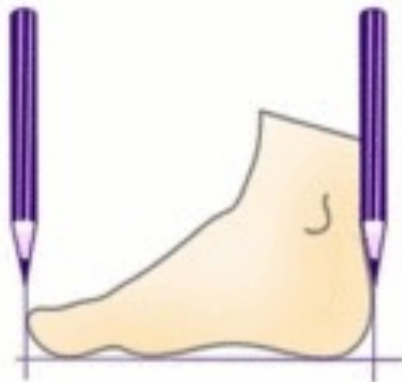
<b>Abbreviation</b>	<b>Description</b>
BLO	back loop only
ch	chain stitch
dc	double crochet
FLO	front loop only
hdc	half double crochet
hdc2tog	half double crochet 2 stitches together
inc	increase - work 2 sc in 1 st of previous rnd
dc inc	double crochet increase - work 2 dc in 1 st of previous rnd
PM	place marker
RS	right side
sc	single crochet

<b>Abbreviation</b>	<b>Description</b>
sl st	slip stitch
WS	wrong side
(...)	number of sts in total
rep (...) *N	repeat in brackets N times
rep	repeat
invisible join	cut the thread approx. 4 cm, pull through the last sc, insert the hook into the first st of the previous round, yarn over and pull the tail of yarn through st before the last WS, fasten off.
dc2tog	double crochet 2 stitches together
dc3tog	double crochet 3 stitches together

## SIZE:

When using similar materials, the booties will be 9 cm / 3 ½ inches length.

Foot inner length

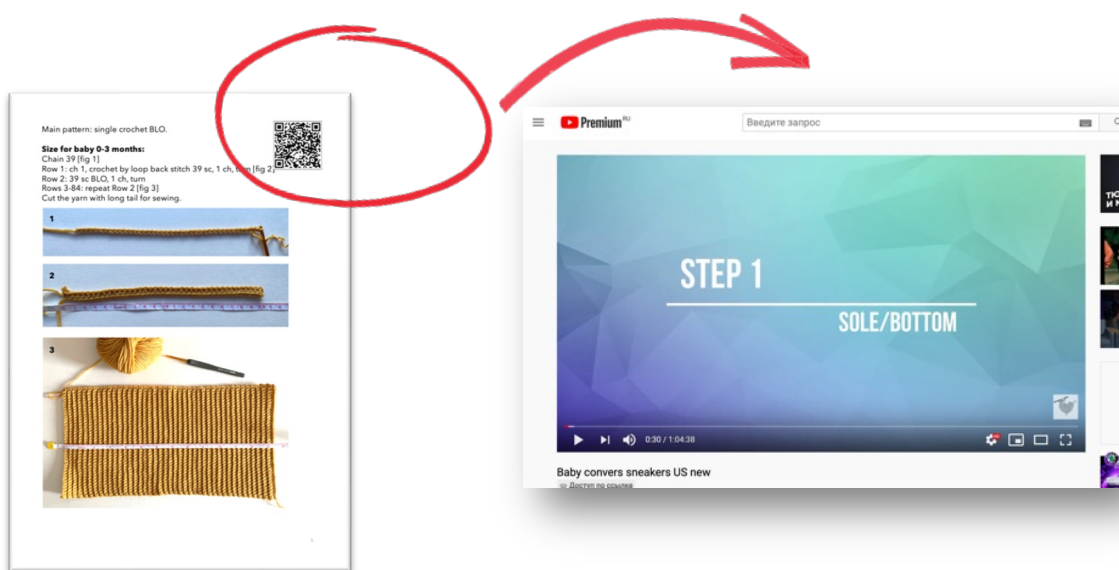


For larger booties, use a thicker yarn such as Light (#3)/DK

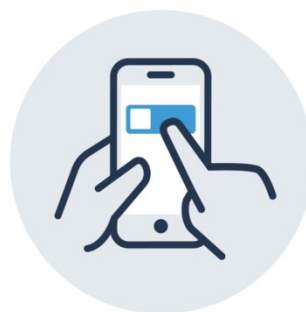
**If** you print out, you can scan the QR to open the video on your smartphone or tablet.

## 1. THE SOLE/BOTTOM



Chain 14. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain. PM to indicate the beginning of the round.

**Rnd 1:** ch 2, 2 dc in the 14<sup>th</sup> ch, 12 dc, 5 dc in one st; turn around and work onto the backside of the foundation chain: 12 dc, 2 dc in one st, sl st (34) [fig 1]



**Rnd 2:** ch 1, 2 inc, 5sc, 2 hdc, 5dc, rep (dc inc)\*5, 5 dc, 2 hdc, 5sc, 2 inc, 1 sc, sl st (44) [fig 2]



**Rnd 3:** ch 2, rep (dc inc)\*4, 12 dc, rep (dc inc)\*10, 12 dc, rep (dc inc)\*4, 1dc, sl st (62) Don't cut the yarn [fig 3]

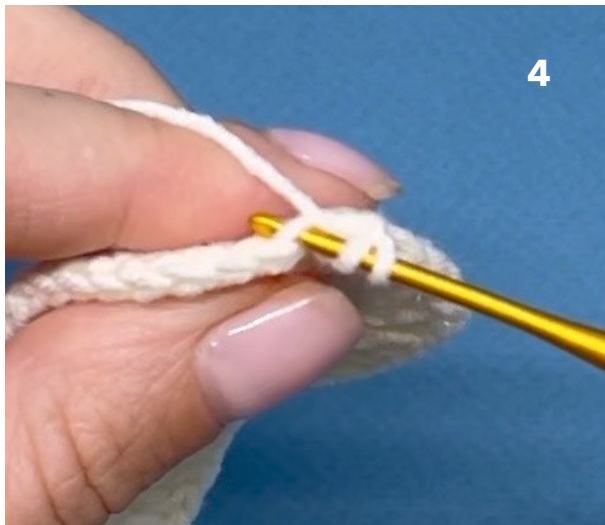


## 2. SIDES OF THE SOLE.



With the sole WS up, start working on the sides. Continue crocheting with white yarn.

**Rnd 4:** crochet blo: ch 2, 61 hdc, sl st under the beg of rnd (62) [fig 4, 5]



**Rnd 5:** ch 2, 61 hdc (62) [fig 6]



inc increase - work 2 sc in 1 st of previous rnd

BLO back loop only

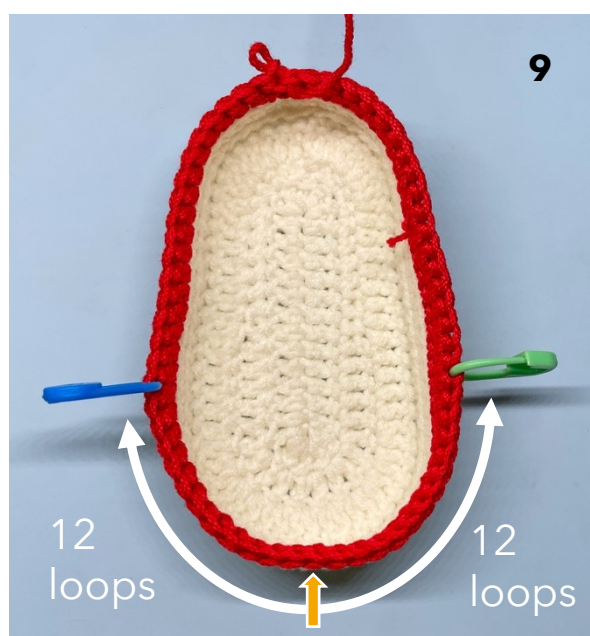
Take red yarn.

We start from the loop to the left of the invisible loop of the previous round [fig 7]



**Rnd 6:** ch 1, 61 sc, sl st (62)

**Rnd 7:** ch 1, 61 sc, sl st (62) [fig 8]



centro

- PM1 to indicate 13<sup>th</sup> st from the middle of the front of shoe to the left,
- PM2 to indicate 13<sup>th</sup> st from the middle of the front of shoe to the right [24 sts].



### 3. SHOE SIDES

**Rnd 8:** ch 1, sc\* till marker, remove marker, 1 sc, put marker, rep (dc2tog) \*12, remove marker, 1 sc, put marker, sc\* till the end, st sl (50) [fig 10]



**Rnd 9:** ch 1, 49 sc, sl st (50) [fig 11]



**Rnd 10:** ch 1, sc\* till marker , rep(dc2tog)\*6, sc\* till the end, sl st (44) [fig 12]



**Rnd 11:** ch 1, 43 sc, sl st (44) [fig 13]



dc3tog    double crochet 3 stitches together

**Rnd 12:** ch 1, sc\* till marker, rep(dc3tog)\*2, sc\* till the end, sl st (40) [fig 14]



**Rnd 13:** ch 2, 39 dc, sl st (40)

**Rnd 14:** ch 2, 39 dc, sl st (40)

**Rnd 15:** ch 2, 39 dc (40) [fig 15]

Cut the yarn, invisible join in end of the round.





Take the white yarn.

**Rnd 16:** ch 2, 39 dc, sl st (40)

**Rnd 17:** ch 2, 39 dc (40) [fig 16]

Cut the yarn, invisible join in end of the round.



To create Christmas stocking from these booties is easy!

Take the white yarn and make 25-30 chain.



Crochet the second booties using the pattern.

*TIP: to make the booties **the same**, I recommend crocheting both at once - that is, crochet the sole of one and immediately crochet the sole of the second booties. Crocheted the sides of the sole of one and followed by the side of the sole of the other, and so on.*

You can decorate your boots with a belt buckle.

Crochet a buckle with yellow yarn:

Chain 7, dc in the 4<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook, 3 dc.

Cut the yarn.



We use black yarn for the belt.

Ch ±52, hdc in the 3<sup>th</sup> ch from the hook, hdc\*till the end.

Put the buckle on the belt and sew the belt into a ring.



Enjoy your new cute Santa booties!
