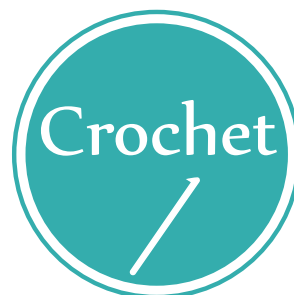


Princess Crown



BEGINNER



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Sizes:

SIZE	HEAD CIRCUMFERENCE	* CROWN WIDTH
Doll	11.5" - 12.5" (29.2 - 31.75 cm)	5.25" (13.4cm)
0-3 mos	12.5" - 13.5" (31.75 - 34.3 cm)	6" (15.2 cm)
3-6 mos	14" - 15.5" (35.5 - 39.4 cm)	6.75" (17.1 cm)
6-12 mos	15.5" - 17.5" (39.4 - 44.5 cm)	7.5" (19 cm)
1-3 yrs	17.5" - 19" (44.5 - 48.3 cm)	8.25" (21 cm)
3-5 yrs	19" - 20.5" (48.3 - 52 cm)	9" (22.9 cm)
5 yrs - Preteens	20.5" - 21.5" (52 - 54.6 cm)	9.75" (24.8 cm)
Adults Medium	21.5" - 23" (54.6 - 58.4 cm)	10.5" (27.3 cm)
Adults Large	23" - 25" (58.4 - 63.5 cm)	11.25" (28.6 cm)

*CROWN WIDTH = 1/2 of crown circumference.

TIPS: Measure the crown as shown below (photo 1). The crown will stretch to fit to the specified head sizes. If you wish to wear the crown over crochet hat, you need to make the crown **1-2 sizes larger** than your hat to make it fit comfortably.



Materials:

- **Red Heart Super Saver Yarn** - 100% acrylic; 7 oz / 198 g; 364 yd / 333 m; **Weight category:** 4 / Worsted; **Qty:** small amount
- Beads or other jewels (optional)
- Sewing needle or Hot glue gun (optional)

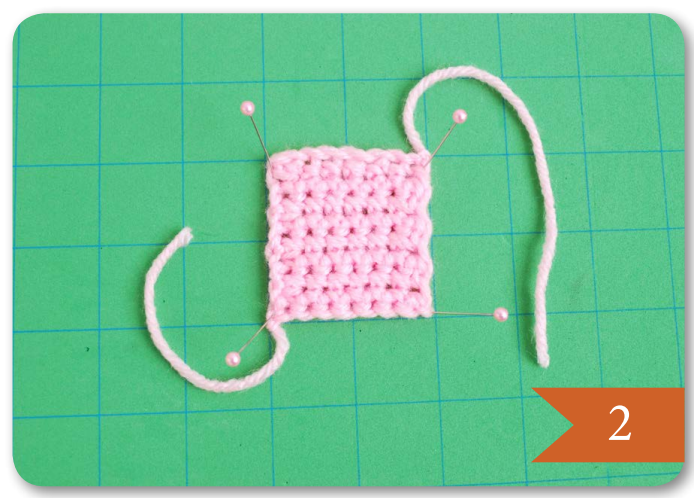
Hook:

- 3.75 (F)

Gauge:



- 8 sc sts X 8 rows = 2" X 2" (5 X 5 cm)

NOTE: Please check your tension before starting your work (photo 2). Use any hook size to obtain the gauge.

*This pattern is written using US terms (including special stitches section).

Special Stitches:

- **Shell** – (2 dc, 2 tr, picot, 2 tr, 2 dc) in same st.
- **Picot** - Chain 3; insert hook between the front & back lps of previous st; yo & pull through all lps on hook.

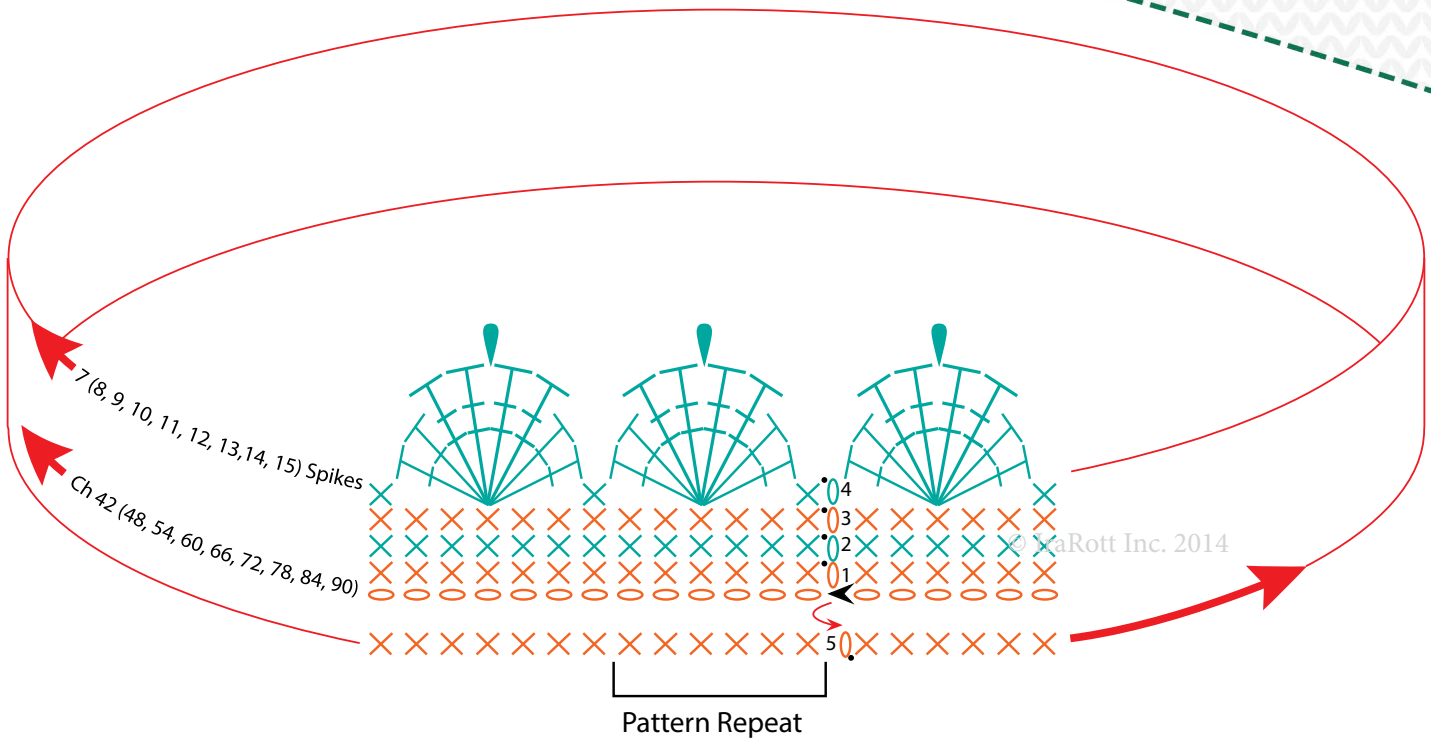

Doll:

To begin: ch 42 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 42 sts

Rnd 2: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 42 sts

Rnd 3: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 7 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 7 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 4 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 42 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

0-3 mos:

To begin: ch 48 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 48 sts

Rnd 2: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 48 sts

Rnd 3: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 8 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 8 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 4 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 48 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

3-6 mos:

To begin: ch 54 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 54 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 54 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 9 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 9 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 54 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

6-12 mos:

To begin: ch 60 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 60 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 60 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 10 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 10 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 60 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

1-3 yrs:

To begin: ch 66 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 66 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 66 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 11 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 11 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 66 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

3-5 yrs:

To begin: ch 72 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 72 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 72 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 12 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 12 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 72 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

5 yrs - Preteens:

To begin: ch 78 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 78 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 78 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 13 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 13 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 78 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

Adults Medium:

To begin: ch 84 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 84 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 84 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 14 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 14 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 84 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

Adults Large:

To begin: ch 90 loosely; join ch with a sl st to work in the round (do not twist the chain!)

Rnd 1: ch 1; sc in ea ch around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 90 sts

Rnd 2-3: ch 1; sc in ea st around; join with sl st in top of beg st = 90 sts

Rnd 4: ch 1; [sc in next st, skip 2 sts, shell in next st, skip 2 sts] 15 times; join with sl st in top of beg st; **fasten off** = 15 crown spikes

With RS of the crown facing you, join yarn at the bottom edge of the crown (in beg st of Rnd 1) & work the edging round:

Rnd 5 (edging): ch 1; sc in ea st around the edge; join with sl st in top of beg st = 90 sts

Finishing: fasten off & weave in all the ends on WS

Finishing Crown:

- After you finish crocheting, your crown may look rumpled (photo 3).



- Smooth out the crown with your hands before wearing, or wet block the crown after finishing.



- Sew the beads (jewels) around the crown, or use a hot glue gun to glue them onto the spikes (optional).
